Shikataganai



Welcome to the month of February! I tore my Achilles tendon last November, and I am recovering well. I have come to understand how elderly people feel by experiencing limited mobility.

The Vancouver Buddhist Temple is hosting the 71st BC Jodo Shinshu Buddhist Convention on September 20th and 21st 2025. At last year's convention, in Harrison Hot Springs, we learned about three expressions that

were often used by the Japanese Canadians during the war-time interment experience. They are:

- 1. Ganbatte (do your best)
- 2. Okagedama (because of others)
- 3. Shikataganai

We have decided that the theme of the convention is "Shikataganai." Shikataganai means, "There is no other way of dealing with it" or "It cannot be helped." In Jodo Shinshu terms, Shikataganai reads, "omakase" or "leaving such matters to the Buddha." It is the moment of realizing that all our attempts to seize, reason out, and intuit enlightenment are simply self-centred conceits. It is the moment of experiencing that the True and Real are not constructions of the mind.

I will continue to write about "Shikataganai" in the next issue.

Japanese Dharma Message

バンクーバー仏教会120周年を終えて

昨年は、バンクーバー仏教会の開教 1 2 0 周年、建物 4 5 周年を無事に迎えました。この大きな岐路を迎え、今までの歴史を振り返ると共に、現在の我々のありかた、また今後をよく考えるご縁でもありました。いつまでも、争いが絶えない混沌とした世の中が続いています。よりいっそう、仏教・浄土真宗のみ教えを伝えていく必要を感じます。

アインシュタイン博士が1922年(大正11年)に日本に来日した時の話しです。日本各地を訪れる中で、日本の仏教に関心を持っていた博士は、浄土真宗の僧侶である近角常観(ちかずみ じょうかん)師と会いました。そこで、アインシュタイン博士は「仏さまとはどういうお方ですか?」との質問をされ、それに対して近角先生は「姥捨て山(うばすてやま)」のお話をされました。

昔、信濃の国では、親が年を取って一定の年齢になると、食い扶持を減らすということで、山に捨てに行かなければならない掟のある時代があったのです。息子が、やむなく年老いた母を背中に背負って、山の奥へと上っていく途中に、母は手に触れる木の枝を折っては道に落とし、を繰り返していました。息子はその様子を感じながら「母はまさか、寂しくて村に帰ろうとするときにこの折った枝を頼りに山を降りようと目印に枝を折っているのではあるまいか?」と母を疑っていたようです。ところが、山の捨て場について、いよいよ母を捨てて帰ろうとするそのときに、母は息子に言いました。「山もだいぶん奥まで来て、お前が村に帰るときに道に迷わないように枝を折って道に落としておいたからそれを頼りにしていけば間違えることなく帰れるから、気を付けて帰れよ。」と、合掌して別れを告げたそうです。その言葉を聞いて息子は泣き崩れ「なんと私は恐ろしいことを考えていたのだろう。わたしは母を捨てよう、帰ってきてもらっては困ると考えていたのに、母は見捨てられるのにも関わらず私のことを案じていてくれる。」と、母に両手をついて謝り、母を再び背中に乗せて山を降りたということです。近角先生はアインシュタイン博士に「この母の姿こそ仏様の姿であります。」と話されたそうです。


